



**4TH ANNUAL BASIC SKILLS COMPETITION
SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 22nd, 2008**

It is our pleasure to have your child participating in the Gate City Learn to Skate 4th Annual Basic Skills Competition. Enclosed is all pertinent information you will need for the day of the competition. On behalf of Conway Arena we hope this competition is rewarding and enjoyable for your skater.

Registration Information: Skaters must arrive one hour before their scheduled competition time, except for the first groups of the day, which can arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of the competition. Upon arrival, please check in at the registration table in the front lobby and reference your event. If you are competing in a program, make sure to turn in your tape/CD at this time. It must be labeled with your name and event and must also be REWOUND. Please bring an extra copy of your tape/CD as backup as well. Locker rooms will be assigned to all skaters and will be available at check in. Parent(s) may bring their skater to the locker rooms to get settled but are asked to leave. There will be a proctor for each locker room. Proctors will be responsible for bringing skaters to the ice. Medals will be given for all placements. Medal ceremony times will be posted at the Arena.

Directions to Conway Arena, Nashua NH.

From South US-3 North . Proceed north on US-3 Exit 5W(Rt-111). At the end of the ramp, bear right onto Rt-111W. Proceed west on Rt-111 approx. 0.35 miles. Take the first right immediately after the Nashua Police Station onto Panther Drive and proceed north approx. 0.1 mile to Riverside St. (stop sign). Watch for Conway Arena directly ahead.

From North Follow Everett Turnpike to Exit 5w. At the end of the ramp bear right onto Rt-111. Proceed west on Rt-111 approx. 0.35 miles. Take the first right immediately after the Nashua Police Station onto Panther Drive and proceed north approx. 0.1 mile to Riverside St. (stop sign). Watch for Conway Arena directly ahead
